### **Minutes From Prior Meeting Approval**

- Review of March 5th 2024 Regular Meeting Notes as amended
  - Motion to Approve; Seconded, Approved 4-0

#### **Finance Review**

- Working through some checks that have not been cashed
- Budget discussion
  - Driveway paving mishap; reimbursed by CAPRI + company
  - o Driveway/Parking Lot sealant contractor redo/tune up + repaint
  - o Driveway + Sidewalk actual expenses (in 2024 capital expenditures) will likely increase
  - Need to seal coat driveway every 3 years
    - Good to put in capital improvements tracker
- Percent of budget year-to-date numbers
  - Aquatics income significantly over budget (260%)
  - Landscaping over budget but have had significant work (fence repair, new pool related work)
- Water / Gas
  - Gas meter replaced hadn't been charging us it's now up-to-date and working
  - Water more reasonable this past round; YTD at budget
- Additional costs to cover new pool final items
  - Will need to monitor and discuss as needed

### **Pool Report**

- Baby pool is open amazing!
  - Current hours: 11:45 2 and then 4 to 6 (check website for updates!)
  - Working through plan to extend hours as we come out of normal "winter" season
- Summer Lifeguard coverage
  - Summer lifeguard coverage is looking good
  - Discussion of desk greeter to help cover hours
- Waterpolo
  - Continues through early May
  - Has worked out well; Ladera kids in program, at off hours, financial benefit
- We have an official temporary approval for main and wading pools through October 14th
  - Based off 2021 permit and parcel numbers
- Two open items
  - o Bioswale paperwork odd and ends. Not viewing it as a significant hurdle to overcome.
  - o Larger issue Geotechnical approval
    - Turnover/handoffs between companies + missed communication + no current ownership on remaining companies willing to sign
    - LRD had Construction Services do the inspection; passed based off the design specified by Terracon
    - County won't approve until engineer of record signs
    - Next steps
      - In touch with original Terracon members (now at RSM) and Tricon
      - Regroup early May

### Manager's Report

- Memberships community 121; had 137 at this time; a bit behind from last year
  - Likely Canada College facility impact; significantly different experience
  - Team working through various membership drive ideas
    - Comparing last years memberships to figure who haven't signed up yet doing some sort of communication
    - Signage (e.g. at entrance to Ladera; "Baby pool open!")
    - If community sign ups don't increase open up more non-resident membership spots
    - Crier + Ladera List serve notifications (broaden communication to list serve)
    - New residents some sort of Welcome in mailboxes?
    - Early season open to the community day / replacement for our "Neptune Day"
  - Optimistic with youth committee ideas; kids excited about opportunities/structure of program
- Programming
  - Much appreciation for the amazing newsletter; lots going on
  - Broaden the audience to list serve?
- Administration
  - Lights are in have some tune ups needed; in progress

- New heaters/AC are in for the main room/office to replace the old broken ones
- 4th of July schedule in progress
- Summer hiring complete
- Quotes received for resurfacing Tennis Courts 3 and 4
  - \$95k / \$97k / \$25k options to work through details/analysis/next steps
- Landscaping: playground area and parking lot bumper tune ups
- Pool hour discussion
  - Current plan is to be consistent with last years hours
  - Soon to be transitioning from traditional early season hours to busier season
  - Lifeguard staffing during day is a consistent challenge
  - To consider ways to enhance coverage/open hours
    - E.g. hire additional staff?
- Membership dates discussion
  - Need to tune up disconnect between sign up date and membership start date (e.g. you purchase membership on Feb 15 but membership doesn't start to April 1st)
  - Had some folks understandably think their membership started when they signed up
  - To consider ways to handle for next year
- Camp attendance in last 3 sessions usually a bit lower
  - To explore some marketing; e.g. Los Lomitas, Oak Knoll school updates
- Board/Management vision discussion check in
  - New pool, grounds, programming, communications all super positive
  - Keep feedback coming in
- Work on mailing
  - Content from Board could be of benefit
  - Push to increase Ladera community memberships
  - Possible inclusion of survey
- Mothers Day May 12 usually a busy day
- Audit
  - Audit distributed; board to read through/send feedback
