#### **Public Discussion**

#### **Minutes From Prior Meeting Approval**

- Review of April 17th 2024 Regular Meeting Notes as amended
  - Motion to Approve with minor adjustment; Seconded, Approved 4-0

#### **Finance Review**

- Review of documents
  - Reviewing Budget Capital expenditures document
    - Document does not cover operating expenses; intent is to cover expenses to be paid for via excess from operating income or other sources (e.g. capital reserves, pool fund)
    - Expected lifespan is considered as part of depreciation
    - New lights are in place, considerably under budget
  - Cash flow document
    - Discussion about where/what document to reflect Sterling loan payment
- Budget vs Actuals
  - Net Operating Income our budget is to end the year at \$321k
  - Chemicals relatively low expenses so far this year; will pick up in the summer; also added compound to make it so the chlorine doesn't burn off as much - that has helped
  - o In progress on updating hourly swim lesson rate

## Manager's Report

- Membership counts now consistent with last year at this time
  - 139 resident families this year, 140 last year
  - Non-resident families at 120
  - Total revenue exceeds budget for memberships
- Discussion about opening up memberships to the 9 non-resident families on the waitlist
  - Agreement to let in
- Discussion about an annual "Neptune" Day to reflect the "beginning of the season"
- Camp Ladera Sign ups have increased; last 3 weeks still a bit low
- Dolphins swim team a bit low but pretty normal signup behavior for this time of year
- Pool backwash issue
  - Fixed this morning, still checking to make sure all ok
  - Exploring extension of warranty
  - Sunday pool was 4" low; backwash had started, but just kept going.
    - Have to manually turn off pumps
    - The pool needs to be able to auto backwash (what the equipment is intended to do)
    - Valves getting stuck
    - Seems to be good for 15 backwashes and then runs into issues
    - In progress with contractor to resolve
  - To empower lifeguards to take action (knowing signals to identify that there is an issue, knowing what valve to adjust, and then doing it)
- Fitness classes
  - In discussions with a couple studios
  - Marti T to host Yoga classes
- Exploring Water Aerobics
- "Unofficial" masters swim meet in the works
- Late May/June lots of parties scheduled (graduation, birthdays, etc)
- Staffing discussion
  - Most significant challenge during "off season" is finding lifeguards
  - Key to make sure we are good for coverage during the "summer season" and a defined approach for "who is responsible" when management team is not on site
  - Broader/longer term topic to consider: do we have the appropriate staffing structure in place to run the LRD "as a business" or are adjustments needed?

#### **Pool Report**

- Working through next steps on finalizing permits
- Wading pool has been busy in the afternoons, families/kids loving it
- Donor Wall progressing, should be here soon!
- Request for last tranche of Prop 60 money (\$37k) has been submitted
- Asphalt contractor resealed
- In discussions with Tricon on sidewalk
